Seplat Energy Plc is committed to maintaining high standards of Health, Safety and Environment (“HSE”) performance across all areas of its Energy business. Our aim is always to provide a healthy and safe workplace at every location, minimize the effects of our activities on the environment and our host communities.



Seplat Energy Leadership and staff are committed to:

- The provision of safe and healthy working conditions for the prevention of work-related injury and ill health.
- The protection of the environment, including prevention of pollution, sustainable resource use, climate change mitigation and adaptation, and protection of biodiversity and ecosystems.
- The conservation of natural resources through the adoption of energy efficient processes and technologies, waste avoidance, recycling and reutilization
- The fulfilment of legal requirements, and other stakeholders’ requirements.
- The elimination of hazards and reduction of occupational health and safety risks.
- The continual improvement of our HSE management systems to enhance HSE performance through the adoption of the best available technologies and training.
- The consultation and participation of workers and their representatives.

To achieve the above commitments and improve our HSE performance, we will:

- Involve senior management in facilities inspection, HSE performance reviews and the establishment of a generative HSE culture.
- Conduct our operations in compliance with all applicable laws, regulations, permits and industry best practice to ensure continued support from our host communities, equity investors, lenders and other stakeholders.
- Ensure that all levels of our personnel are appropriately skilled and receive regular training.
- Empower every employee to intervene and stop any activity they consider to be unsafe to personnel and/or the environment.
- Establish a robust asset integrity management system that will guarantee the safety of our facilities and the operating environment.
- Establish and implement measures that promote the good health of our employees.
- Ensure all employees and contractors are provided with appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and are used in line with Seplat’s PPE Policy.
- Make compliance with Seplat’s HSE policies a condition of employment for both Seplat and contractors’ employees.
- Promptly report and investigate all incidents, including Near misses, to determine cause and share findings across the organization and with contractors.
- Conduct regular exercises to train all personnel on emergency response procedures and preventative actions.
- Prevent or mitigate the environmental impact resulting from our operations including with regards to air quality, surface water, soil and groundwater, biodiversity and greenhouse gas emissions.
- Commit to conserve natural resources through the adoption of energy efficient processes and technologies, waste avoidance, recycling and reutilization.
- Hold accountable and support our suppliers, contractors, and non-operated venture partners to same level of HSE management standard.
